Governmental Affairs

New York State Senate Bills of Interest

From the Desk of Justin Merriam, RAC NYSCAR Governmental Affairs Chair:

- [Senate Bill S1708A](#): Enacts the "bank of Rochester act," whose purpose is to authorize the city of Rochester to establish and operate the Bank of Rochester to support local economic development initiatives such as improving infrastructure, supporting local businesses and addressing housing needs.

- [Senate Bill S5549](#): Prohibits exemptions for owners of vacant or unoccupied storefront properties
- [Senate Bill S2007](#): Expands the residential-commercial exemption program to include any municipality regardless of the population of the county in which it is located.
